- Because you can see your energy usage on the display screen (IHD) this helps you think about how much energy you use

- Smart meters could help to make your bill correct
- Meter Readings are done automatically, so you don't have to do them
- You can see how much gas/ electricity is being used in pounds and pence using the display.
- Prepay customers can see how much credit they have and top up more easily
