In February 1988 Rob, and a small group from his Day Centre, came together to start

Speakup Speakup



At that time People with a Learning Disability had very little opportunity to make their own decisions



Rob and his Day Centre friends thought things needed to change ...

All People should have a Voice, be Heard and be given the opportunity to make their own Decisions







#### 3. Rotherham ... and beyond



Rob was elected "Chair" of the Speakup Committee



And shortly afterwards he became "Co-Chair" of the Learning Disability Partnership Board at Rotherham Council



The Partnership Board tells the Council what Services are needed for People with a Learning Disability



How the Services should work ...

And checks to make sure the Services are working well









Looking towards the Health and Welfare of People in Rotherham Rob has also been a member of the Health Select Commission

#### ... and beyond Rotherham



Rob was asked to sit on the Government Task Force



The job of the 4 people on the Task Force was to feed back to Government the things People with a Learning Disability saw as being important







One of the biggest, and most important, pieces of work of the Task Force was their contribution to the writing of the ...

Mental Capacity Act



This Law has made a very big difference to the lives of People with a Learning Disability



People can now have their Voice Heard



And can show that they have the Capacity to make their own Choices and Decisions













Rob worked with the Commission for Social Care Inspection (CSCI) to start the Expert by Experience programme



When the CSCI changed to become the Care Quality Commission (CQC) Rob became one of the CQC Expert by Experience inspectors



Rob travelled throughout the country to inspect Day Services and Residential Services to make sure that People were happy and safe
